

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT PROGRAM
Rules and Conditions

1. Students shall obey the Laws of Canada. It is a violation of the law to consume alcohol or to be in the possession of or consume illegal drugs. Students who chose to not follow the Laws of Canada will be referred to the Director of International for SD73 and they will be at risk of being removed from the Kamloops Thompson International Program and their student visa revoked.
2. Students are not permitted to operate motorized vehicles.
3. Students may not undertake any life changing activity during their stay in Kamloops. This includes such things as getting tattoos or piercing.
4. Students are expected to live with a Canadian Homestay family and participate in the family activities and follow family rules and practices. Any homestay move by request of the student may result in an additional fee of \$250.00
5. All student technology such as laptops, cell phones or the accompanying cell phone plans are the responsibility of the student.
6. Travel outside the city of Kamloops and within British Columbia is allowed **with the host parents**. Any other travel must receive prior written approval by the host family and the natural family. A detailed **Consent and Release for Specific Travel** must be completed by the student with the host family and a signed copy sent to the International Student Office at least **two weeks** prior to the event. It is mandatory that an acceptable responsible adult will be at the point of destination. Final approval is the right of the District Principal of International or designate.
7. **Students must attend school regularly and punctually and make a sincere effort to succeed.** If these conditions are not sufficiently met the student may be asked to leave. .

Having read and understood the "International Student Program Rules and Conditions", we agree to abide by these rules and conditions and understand that any violation may result in termination of the International Student experience with **no refund of fees**. We further agree that the School District and the District Superintendent of Schools or designate shall have final authority in enforcing these rules and conditions.
